

General Information

All children must be toilet trained and at least three years old by Monday of the week for which they are enrolling.

Montessori Academy of Cincinnati provides 2% milk at lunch time.

Paperwork, including Emergency Transportation and Medical Forms, will be sent to you upon receipt of your application. These must be submitted prior to beginning our Summer Camp.

Camp tuition and extended care fees are non-refundable and are payable with the application. However, if enrolling in more than four weeks, a minimum of two weeks' tuition and fees are due with your application and **will apply to your last two weeks of camp.**

June's remaining tuition and fees will be due June 1.
July's and August's remaining tuition and fees will be due July 6.

Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis.

June 21 ~ 25

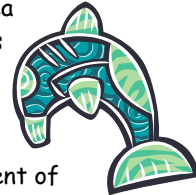
Community Heroes

Sea Creatures

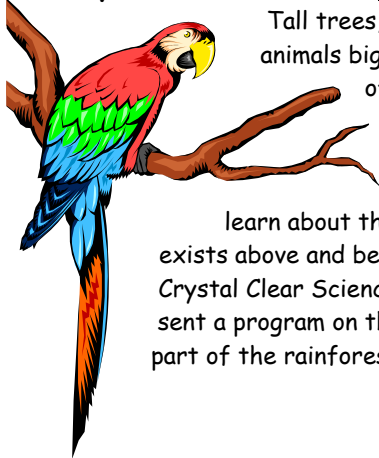

The Exotic Amazon

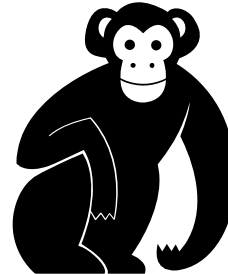

Bon Appetit

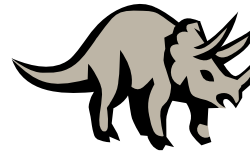
Special snacks prepared by all of the "chef" campers are on the menu this week. They will mix it up with a series of interesting ingredients to produce mouth-watering, tasty treats.

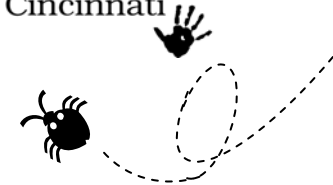
