

## General Information

All children must be toilet trained and at least three years old by Monday of the week for which they are enrolling.

Montessori Academy of Cincinnati provides 2% milk at lunch time.

Paperwork, including Emergency Transportation and Medical Forms, will be sent to you upon receipt of your application. These must be submitted prior to beginning our Summer Camp.

Camp tuition and extended care fees are non-refundable and are payable with the application. If enrolling for more than four weeks, a minimum of two weeks' tuition and fees are due with your application and **will apply to your last two weeks of camp.**

**Priority enrollment deadline for 2017-18 MAC students is April 28, 2017.** After April 28, enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis.

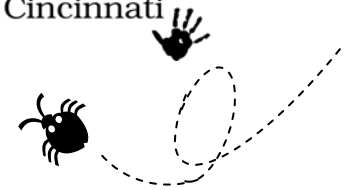
